

- Apply to wood whose usage, nature, quality, treatments and preparation comply with the applicable standards and DTU (DTU 59.1). The inspection and preparation of the surface are the responsibility of the person applying the product.
- The wood must be clean, dry, sound, prepared (degrease, sand, dust if necessary), not frozen or rimed.

On new wood:

- Sand (grit 120) to encourage and optimise the opening of the pores.

On old wood:

- Expose the surface by sanding or stripping.

NB: After sanding, brush sanding, always meticulously dust the surface.

Recommendations before application

- Shake well before application.
- Do not apply at an ambient air and wood temperature of less than +10°C and greater than +30°C. The relative humidity should be of the order of 50% for optimum drying.
- Comply with the applicable standards and DTU.
- Protect everything that does not have to be treated.
- The moisture of the wood should not be greater than 15%.

Directions for use

According to the surface condition:

New wood:

- After sanding, apply the protection.

Weathered wood:

- Clean with Wood Cleaner*, rinse and allow to dry.
- Sand (grit 120) if necessary.
- Apply the protection.

Darkened, oiled wood:

- Remove oil with Wood Oil Cleaner*, neutralise with Wood Cleaner* rinse and allow to dry.
- Sand (grit 120) if necessary.
- Apply the protection.

Wood to be stripped: consult us.

New wood system:

- Apply a generous coat of Linitop Prim & Finish* or Linitop Acryl Prim*.
- After drying complete with 2 coats of Linitop Color Mix.

Advice of the professionals

The Linitop Prim & Finish* or Linitop Acryl Prim* undercoat does not always have to be applied. You need to apply it to woodwork that is not yet impregnated. If the Linitop Prim & Finish* or Linitop Acryl Prim* should not be applied, it is preferable to dilute the 1st coat of Linitop Color Mix by 5 to 10%.

Maintenance

Apply 1 to 2 coats of Linitop Color Mix depending on the condition of the surface, after having brushed or sanded.

NB: After sanding/brush sanding, always meticulously dust the surface.
